What is a SYNONYM?


A synonym is a word that has the same meaning as another word.

Let's practice using these synonyms:

tiny	↔	small
many	↔	plenty
big	↔	large
bad	↔	awful
strong	↔	tough

TINY

Look!
There's
a girl on
the
flower!
The girl
is **tiny**.



SMALL

She is
very
small.

The squirrel eats nuts. It likes the nuts. It plays with them.

MANY

There are **many** nuts.

PLENTY

The nuts are **plenty**.



Taro has a sweet, yellow pear.
He's going to eat the pear.

BIG

This pear
is very **big**.

LARGE

It is **large**.




Emma can't go to school.
